

POPE FRANCIS- "Jesus enters into His public ministry after a quiet life in Nazareth: He invites everyone to conversion, calls His first disciples, and gives the mission to spread the Good News of God's boundless love for all. This "dynamism" shows us how the Word is for everyone, the Word calls everyone to conversion, the Word makes us heralds. When it enters us, the Word transforms our hearts and minds: it changes us and leads us to direct our lives to the Lord...Here is Jesus' invitation: God has come close to you; recognize His presence, make room for His Word, and you will change your outlook on life. Jesus wants to reach those far away, He wants to heal the sick, He wants to save sinners. He wants to gather the lost sheep and lift up those whose hearts are weary and oppressed. In short, Jesus 'reaches out' to tell us that God's mercy is for everyone. We must not forget this: God's mercy is for everyone."

INVISIBLE UNIVERSITY -"Invisible University is set up for students from Ukraine. With Russia's invasion of Ukraine ongoing, the Central European University (CEU) has launched an 'Invisible University for Ukraine' in Hungary's capital Budapest. Among those studying here are students forced to flee their wartorn nation or otherwise impacted by Europe's most significant armed conflict since World War II. The program started online and soon became the 'Invisible University.'

PAKISTAN- "Major power fault leaves Pakistan in darkness. Around 220 million people in Pakistan are suffering from a massive electricity outage after a failure of the national grid. Just about everywhere is without power, from hospitals and schools to supermarkets, factories and millions of dwellings." MYANMAR – Religious leaders have issued a passionate appeal for peace in the country, insisting that "all of us need to undertake the pilgrimage of peace." The appeal notes that places of worship and monasteries, where communities sought peace and reconciliation are themselves increasingly under attack. Burmese soldiers burned the historic Church of the Assumption in Char Tan to the ground. A nearby convent housing Franciscan sisters was also set ablaze. "In a great country blessed with so many resources, the destruction of lives is a heart-wrenching tragedy."
